



Via car: to public parking lot of IBZ St. Marienthal (to Kloster-Besucher-Parkplatz)

- From the Görlitz direction:
 - The road from the direction of Görlitz is free up to the monastery. The road closure of the B99 applies only after the access to the large parking lot at the monastery site.
- From the Zittau direction:

The approach from the direction of Zittau is more difficult due to road construction works. In Zittau, follow the B99 to the Wittgendorf turnoff. Continue along the main road via Schlegel, Dittersbach and Kiesdorf. In Kiesdorf turn right in the direction of Ostritz. In Ostritz turn right again onto the B99. Continue until the access is free via the large parking lot on the monastery grounds.

Via public transport:

- Via train: Travel to the train station "Krzewina Zgorzelecka", which is in the Polish
 neighbouring village. Then take the bus (line 32 "Löbau Bernstadt Ostritz") to "Ostritz St.
 Marienthal".
